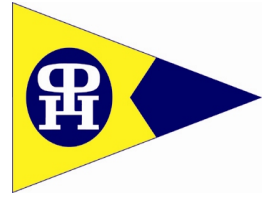

Commodore Brad Kelly was absent from meeting, Rob Prewer, Vice Commodore, ran the meeting in Brad's place. Brad wanted everyone to know that the Lease is before the Town's lawyers, no worries. Eugene Todd said no changes for us. It will be a 1 year lease, no change to the Lease Fee. The depth of The Harbour will be looked after, Eugene Todd is sending down a crew to measure the depth, but dredging Can't start till the end of May, when the fish have finished their laying of eggs. The Building Permit for the Shelter is before the Harbour Commission, once we get approval it will be approximately 2 weeks to Get the Permit.

MEMBERSHIP
